



No contact with farm animals for 7 days prior to travel

If you have been on a farm or in contact with farm animals 7 days before travel, check whether a stand down period is required.



Familiarise yourself with known issues / considerations

Ask your host what the biosecurity requirements are. Use the OIE website to check the biosecurity considerations for the country or region.



Minimise exposure to animals while travelling

Don't have contact with animals or enter operational facilities unless it's absolutely required.



Minimise the need to bring equipment

Arrange to use equipment / instruments provided in country if possible.



Wash your hands

Wash and sanitise your hands regularly.



Clean equipment

Thoroughly clean and dry any equipment or gifts / souvenirs you are returning with.



Leave site-provided footwear / coveralls

If footwear and / or coveralls are provided, leave these at the facility.



Disinfect your own footwear

Remove any organic matter from your footwear, wash and dry the soles, and if possible, soak them in disinfectant.



Hot wash clothing

Hot wash or dry-clean clothing.
