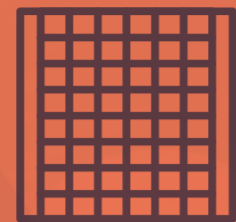


Know your backyard

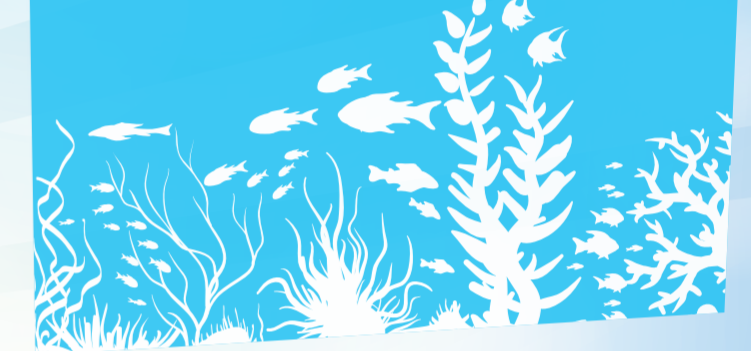
Check, clean, dry

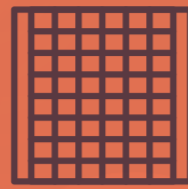
